415 112 Introduction to Sociology 3 (3-0-6)

Definition and development of sociology as a science, methods of social investigation, man and environment, culture, human society and social organization, social group, social institution, deviance and social problems, social and cultural change, social inequality, collective behavior and social movement

415 114 Social Psychology 3 (3-0-6)

Study of definition, scope and research methodology of social psychology, perceiving individuals and groups, social interactions in group, attitudes, norms and behavior of individuals, self and social identity, love aggression, conflict and conflict resolution

415 120 Introduction to Cultural Anthropology 3 (3-0-6)

Definitions and scope of anthropology, methodology in anthropology, evaluation of human and race, major anthropological theories, environment and human adaptation in diversified societies, culture and related studies (including economic, polite family and kinship, and religious system) for understanding of cultural diversity in globalization.

415 210 Rural Sociology 3 (3-0-6)

Content of rural sociology and rural social studies, concepts and theories in analysis of rural society, settlements and occupation, demographic characteristics and way of life, social organization of rural society, rural change and analysis of rural change, rural problems and analysis of rural problems, rural society in the globalization

415 211 Thai Society 3 (3-0-6)

General characteristics of Thai society, concepts and theories to study Thai society, analysis of social institutions, and relationships among rural, urban, and global societies, changes, problems and crises, and ways to solve Thai society problems.

415 212 Urban Sociology 3 (3-0-6)

This course focuses on urbanization, analysis of urban structures, functions, and patterns of relationship, as well as changes and problems occurring in urban society

415 213 Social Problems 3 (3-0-6)

Fundamental understanding of social problem aspects including definitions, characteristics, perspectives, measurement of violence, typology, concepts and theories, causes and impacts, appropriate measures for preventing and solving specific social problem

415 214 Sociology of Organization 3 (3-0-6)

Concept and theories related to sociology of organization, forms and functions of organization in modern and postmodern societies, organizational analysis and inter-organization changes and development

415 215 Development Sociology 3 (3-0-6)

Concept of development sociology, definitions, process and impacts of development, development situation and problems in different regions of world community, methodology for comparative studies and analysis of selected topics in development sociology

Sociological concepts and thoughts including structural function, conflict, symbolic interaction, postmodernism, critical social theories and critical theories, recent debates in sociological theories and trends
- 415 218 Social Organization and Social Control** **3 (3-0-6)**
Concepts and theories related to social organization, social structure, forms and functions of social organizations, social disorganization, concepts, functions, systems of social control, and theories of social control
- 415 225 Anthropological Concepts and Theories** **3 (3-0-6)**
Histories and development of anthropological thoughts, theories, and methods in anthropology, current anthropological theories, anthropological theories and the study of social phenomena
- 415 226 Ethnology** **3 (3-0-6)**
Concepts of ethnology theories of ethnicity, research methodology of ethnic groups, social relationships among ethnic groups, and problems and trends of ethnic groups development in Thailand
- 415 228 Applied Anthropology** **3 (3-0-6)**
Scope and definition of applied anthropology, development of applied anthropology in Thai society and in the world society, principle of applied anthropology in working with various cultural groups, case studies from Thailand and another countries, role of applied anthropology in the present, anthropology in development and social problem solving
- 415 232 Population and Society** **3 (3-0-6)**
Concepts and theories of population growth, theories of population change and economic development, determinants of population growth, population and its relation to resident areas, economic status and gender, fertility and marriage, morbidity and mortality, and mobility and migration
- 415 240 Introduction to Sociological and Anthropological Research Methodology** **3 (2-3-5)**
Inquiry methods, sociological and anthropological research principle, significance of research problem and conceptual framework development roles of concepts and theories in research, research design, data collection, data analysis, report writing and research ethics
- 415 250 Social and Cultural Change** **3 (3-0-6)**
Concepts, methodology, and theories of social and culture change, are emphasizing on social structure and values with rapid changes
- 415 251 Cultural Studies** **3 (3-0-6)**
Histories, concepts, thoughts, methodology, and main theories related to cultural studies culture and Ideology culture meaning and knowledge theories of social and cultural change emphasizing on values with rapid changes
- 415 261 Criminology** **3 (3-0-6)**
Basic concepts and theories of criminology, definition of crimes, criminals and victims, causes of crimes, criminal law enforcement and criminal justice administration, crime prevention, crime solving and crime control in current Thai Society
- 415 312 Political Sociology** **3 (3-0-6)**

Meaning, scope and the origins of political sociology, approaches and key concepts in political sociology, the relationship between social structure, culture and other social institutions, political behavior of people in political process, analysis of power structure and other pressure group, to consider political culture, political socialization, political leader, democracy and political change

415 313 Sociology of Religion 3 (3-0-6)

Evolution of religion, concepts and theories of religion, collective behavior, belief and religion practices of human society, roles and influences of religion on man and society, relationships among religion and other institutions, religion and politics, religion and social stratification

415 314 Sociology of Health 3 (3-0-6)

Concepts and theories in sociology and other disciplines related to health, disease, patients' role, careers in healthcare, and organization of health services in the community

415 315 Human Resource Development 3 (3-0-6)

Humanism and life according to science, social sciences, and humanity perspectives, concepts and theories of human resources and development, relationships among human resources, organizations, and community, analysis and planning of human resource development for economic and social development, Field study

415 324 Anthropology of Art 3 (3-0-6)

The study of arts in terms of form, meaning, role, and adaptation within their sociocultural contexts through anthropological aspects

415 326 Anthropology of the Body 3 (3-0-6)

Exploration of ideas regarding the human body, and critique of knowledge, discourses, and myths on the human body in perspectives of anthropology and related disciplines

415 329 Anthropology of Media 3 (3-0-6)

Anthropological investigation and critique of media, and the impacts of mass media and new media on people and culture in contemporary societies

415 331 Migration and Urbanization 3 (3-0-6)

Theories of migration, types of migration, measurements of migration, migration in some countries especially in Thailand, factors affecting migration, the impacts of migration, urbanization in some countries, the process of city growth, and the relationship between migration and urbanization

415 332 Thai Population and Quality of Life 3 (3-0-6)

General characteristics of Thai population, uses of resources and produce, Thai population changes and resources affecting the quality of life, environmental problems causing deterioration in the quality of life, analysis of local factors affecting the quality of life, means to improve the quality of life, and the quality of life of Thai people

415 334 Comparative Demography 3 (3-0-6)

Sources of international population data, population characteristics population change, population projection and population policy of various countries, comparative analysis of the impact of population change on national development

415 336 Labor and Society 3 (3-0-6)

Basic concepts of labor, labor mobility and migration in industry and impacts, informal labor and effect on economic and social aspects in household and community level, impact of economic and social policies on labor

415 343 Quantitative Research Methodology 3 (2-3-5)

Concepts of quantitative research, research problem identification, conceptual framework development, research design, research hypothesis, population and sample, variable measurement, interview schedule, data processing, data analysis, and research report writing

 Philosophy in phenomenology, application of the qualitative research, characteristics of qualitative research and data, key concepts, process and methodology in qualitative methodology

 Descriptive and inferential statistics, use of statistics for univariate, bivariate for social research, search for size of sample, type of sampling, test of hypothesis of compared means, association and interpretation of data analysis

 The applications of computer programs for data retrieval, data management, for research , and the applications of computer programs for data analysis of quantitative and qualitative research in sociology and anthropology
- 415 347 Evaluation Research** **3 (2-3-5)**
 Basic concept of evaluation research, project writing, program evaluation, patterns of evaluation, data for evaluation, data analysis, writing report of program evaluation, distribution of information evaluation and ethics of evaluation researcher

 Public opinion survey and society, the media and public opinion survey, sampling techniques , question procedures, data collecting , analyzing and interpreting public opinion survey, law related opinion survey

Concept and theories of international cooperation, roles of international organization and regional cooperation organization in development, multinational corporations in world capitalist system, non-governmental organizations, social movement and people networks in international development, analysis of conflicts and solutions in international development

415 411 Sociology of Sexuality 3 (3-0-6)

Knowledge, understanding and attitude towards sex, gender, human sexual behavior, concepts of the female body and the self, sexual relation relate in the social context of culture and power, sex problems and sex counseling in current society

415 412 Economic Sociology 3 (3-0-6)

Boundary of economic sociology and economics, classical economic sociology concepts on the origins and development of capitalism, social consequences of capitalism, contemporary economic sociology concepts on modernization and development, globalization, culture and consumption, and social capital

415 413 Knowledge-based Society 3 (3-0-6)

Concepts and significance of knowledge-based society, methodology and learning process, roles of local community, organizations, institutions, social networks and communication technology in learning process management of society, knowledge management and the applications of knowledge in social developments

415 414 Project Planning and Management 3 (3-0-6)

Philosophies and concepts of planning, planning process, strategic planning, project planning, project analysis, project proposal development, project management, project closing, project monitoring and evaluation
