

- 3. Letters of Recommendation: Two letters of recommendation with the referee's signature and contact
- 4. English Proficiency Test Result: If any for master's candidates /A must for doctoral candidates
- The accepted results are: TOEFL (Paper based), TOEFL (Computer based), TOEFL (Internet based), TOEFL (ITP), IELTS (Academic Module), TU-GET (1000 total), CU-TEP and KKU-AELT (Provided by KKU), any equivalent test or other test results excluded from the list will not be accepted.
